




Kushal Stone Walls is the sole organization in India that provides end to end solutions for anything related to Basalt hand-tooled stone masonry.

Soft Basalt stone with horizontal tack finish. Ashlar wide joint pattern of masonry is used with deep sunk pointing.

Feature: 3 inch stone coping



Retaining wall cladding, Kirloskar Management Institute, Talegaon, Pune


Random Polygonal retaining wall cladding constructed in local Basalt. The masonry uses butti finish with closed joints.

Feature: Precariously done wall gradient.



Walkway, Private Bungalow, Bhugaon, Pune

Ashlar patterned flooring done with wide joints, using soft Basalt.
Vertical tack finish is used for the masonry



Yellow & Grey Basalt Cladding Venkys Farm House, Pune

A unique combination of grey and yellow basalt with contrasting patterns.

Left wall: random polygonal masonry done in soft grey basalt with matt finish and closed joints. Right wall: Yellow Basalt (shipped from Mumbai) in Ashlar masonry with matt finish and closed joints..

Feature: Combination of yellow Ashlar & grey Random masonry patterns.

Local black Basalt cladding with butti finish set in Ashlar closed joint masonry pattern **Feature: Entire Bungalow cladded in stone**




Compound Wall

Rock faced Random rubble masonry with embedded stone chips.

Gate Posts

Soft Basalt in Ashlar closed pattern. Finish is matt

Feature: Wooden door embedded in Stone structure.



Interior Wall cladding


Matt finished soft Basalt, set in Ashlar closed joint pattern.

Feature: Steps -tread & Riser.

Soft Basalt, matt finished set in Ashlar closed joint pattern Feature: "Devali" are also carved (completely hand-tooled) in Soft Basalt.



Fountain Cascade Wall, Lake Town, Pune

Local soft Basalt with matt finish and & closed joints **Feature: Curved & Stepped Masonry**



Overflow Gully Stream Park, Nanded City, Pune

Local hard Basalt, butti finished, set in Random Polygonal masonry.

Feature: Stones are laid concave on the ground in sloping pattern.



Facade cladding, Nano Tech Technology Park, Mumbai University

Ashlar patterned stone masonry in Pune hard Basalt, with butti finish & deep sunk pointing. **Feature: Entire peripheral wall covered in stone.**



Garden Wall, Theme Park, Parel Mumbai

The entire boundary wall of the garden is stone cladded, set in ashlar pattern, using horizontal tack finish. The stone is local (Mumbai) basalt, hence the bluish tinge. Feature: All Vertical joints are closed & horizontal are wide joints.





Garden Wall, Hyde Park, Pune

Butti finished local Basalt used in random polygonal masonry

Feature: A free standing masonry wall entirely in Stone.



Flower Island, Colonnade, B.U. Bhandari Landmarks, Kharadi, Pune

Matt finished Local (Pune) stone is used here, set in random polygonal pattern. Jointing is closed.

Feature: Masonry encircles the flower island slanting inwards.

Planter Box Cladding, Hyde Park, Pune

Butti faced local Basalt set in random polygonal masonry pattern



Yoga Deck, Stream Park, Nanded City, Pune

Butti finished Local Basalt set in Random Polygonal Masonry pattern using deep sunk pointing.

Feature: Outdoor Stone Flooring
